Dear Secretary of state William Gardner:

I am writing to request, under RSA 91-A, and opportunity to review records related to your office's voter list maintenance obligations under the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (NVRA).

The National Voter Registration Act of 1993, 52 U.S.C. § 20501 et seq., requires your office to make available for public inspection "all records concerning the implementation of programs and activities conducted for the purpose of ensuring the accuracy and currency of official lists of eligible voters." 52 U.S.C. § 20507(i).

Pursuant to Section 20507(i) of NVRA, I request that your office provide the opportunity to inspect the following:

1. Documents regarding all registrants who were identified as potentially not satisfying the citizenship requirements for registration from any official information source, including information obtained from the various agencies within the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, NH Dept. of Public Safety, and from your office since January 1, 2012. This request extends to all public documents that provide the name and address of the registrant, the nature and content of any notice sent to the registrant, including the date of the notice, the response (if any) of the registrant, and actions taken regarding the registrant's registration (if any) and the date of the action. This request extends to electronic records capable of compilation.
