Former Speaker of the House William O'Brien announced his endorsement for Dave Wheeler for Executive Council from District 5. He released the following statement.

"I am proud to endorse Dave Wheeler for the District 5 Executive Council seat," Speaker O'Brien said. "There is vital work to be done next session for the citizens of New Hampshire, and Dave is the man for the job. With state tax revenue cratering, there will be tough decisions to make on the Council, and I fully trust Dave Wheeler to make those choices to benefit Granite Staters."
