
U.S. Senate Election


If the 2022 Democratic primary election for U.S. Senate was being held today, 82% of likely Democratic primary voters would vote for U.S. Representative Peter Welch, 6% would vote for activist Isaac Evans-Frantz, 1% would vote for emergency physician Dr. Niki Thran, and less than 1% would vote for another candidate. Ten percent say that they are undecided. This figure includes those who say they have already voted in this election.

Figure 12: If the Democratic primary for the U.S. Senate were held today, who would you support for the Democratic nomination? (Includes those who have already voted)




Welch is by far the most well-known Democratic candidate for U.S. Senate among likely Democratic primary voters: 98% know enough about him to have an opinion, while only 28% have an opinion on Evans-Frantz and only 26% have an opinion on Thran. Welch is extremely popular among likely Democratic primary voters, enjoying a net favorability rating of +81, while Evans-Frantz has a net favorability rating of +1 and Thran has a net favorability rating of -3.


If the 2022 Republican primary election for U.S. Senate was being held today, 30% of likely Republican primary voters would vote for veteran Gerald Malloy, 24% would vote for former U.S. Attorney Christina Nolan, and 3% would vote for investment banker Myers Mermel. Forty-two percent say that they are undecided and 1% say that they have already voted but don't know or can't remember who they voted for. This figure includes those who say they have already voted in this election.

Nolan is the most well-known among likely Republican primary voters; 70% have an opinion on her while 59% have an opinion on Malloy and 42% have an opinion on Mermel. However, Malloy is a good deal more popular, with a net favorability rating of +30, than are Nolan (+9) and Mermel (-1).


Figure 15: Below is a list of some of the candidates who are running for office in the state primary. Please indicate whether you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of each candidate or if you don't know enough about them to say - Likely Republican Primary Voters - July 2022



U.S. House of Representatives Election


If the 2022 Democratic primary election for the U.S. House of Representatives was being held today, 63% of likely Democratic primary voters would vote for State Senate President Pro Tempore Becca Balint, 21% would vote for Lieutenant Governor Molly Gray, 2% would vote for physician Louis Meyers, and less than 1% would vote for another candidate. Thirteen percent say that they are undecided. This figure includes those who say they have already voted in this election.

Figure 16: If the Democratic primary for the U.S. House of Representatives were held today, who would you support for the Democratic nomination? (Includes those who have already voted)




Most likely Democratic primary voters know enough to have an opinion about Balint (88%) and Gray (92%) but only 36% have an opinion about Meyers. Despite a similar number being aware of Balint and Gray, Balint is considerably more popular, with a net favorability rating of +67, compared to a net favorability rating of +23 for Gray and -1 for Meyers.

If the 2022 Republican primary election for the U.S. House of Representatives was being held today, 15% of likely Republican primary voters would vote for podcast host Ericka Redic, 14% would vote for renewable energy professional Liam Madden, and 9% would vote for former U.S. House candidate Anya Tynio. Fifty-eight percent say that they are undecided and 3% say that they have already voted but don't know or can't remember who they voted for. This figure includes those who say they have already voted in this election.

All three candidates are largely unknown to likely Republican primary voters; 53% have an opinion on Madden, 36% have an opinion on Tynio, and 35% have an opinion on Redic. Nor are any of these candidates particularly popular among likely Republican primary voters; Redic has a net favorability rating of +0, Tynio has a net favorability rating of -2, and Madden has a net favorability rating of -23.
