HOUSE BILL 575-FN

AN ACT relative to vaccine and pharmaceutical products purchased, promoted, or

ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the state and its political subdivisions from purchasing, promoting, or distributing any vaccine or pharmaceutical product that has not been tested with voluntary, human, clinical trials.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

The state of New Hampshire and its political 4 subdivisions, including but not limited to counties, cities, towns, precincts, water districts, school 5 districts, school administrative units, or quasi-public entities, shall not purchase, promote, or 6 distribute any vaccine or pharmaceutical product that has not been tested with voluntary, human, 7 clinical trials. 8 2 Department of Health and Human Services; Duties; Reference Added. Amend RSA 125:9, VI 9 to read as follows: 10 VI. Recognize the public health aspects relating to drugs and food under RSA 125:10 and 11 RSA 125:10-a.

METHODOLOGY:

This bill prevents the state or its political subdivisions from purchasing, promoting, or distributing any vaccine or pharmaceutical product that has not been tested with voluntary, human, clinical trials. The Department of Health and Human Services states that, with respect to COVID-19 vaccines specifically, all vaccines are currently purchased by the federal government and distributed to states, although the Department does expect COVID-19 vaccines to become available commercially at some point in 2023. The Department does not anticipate any immediate fiscal impact as a result of vaccines purchased or not purchased because of this bill.
