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## TRUMP LEADS, DESANTIS CRASHES IN NH GOP PRIMARY

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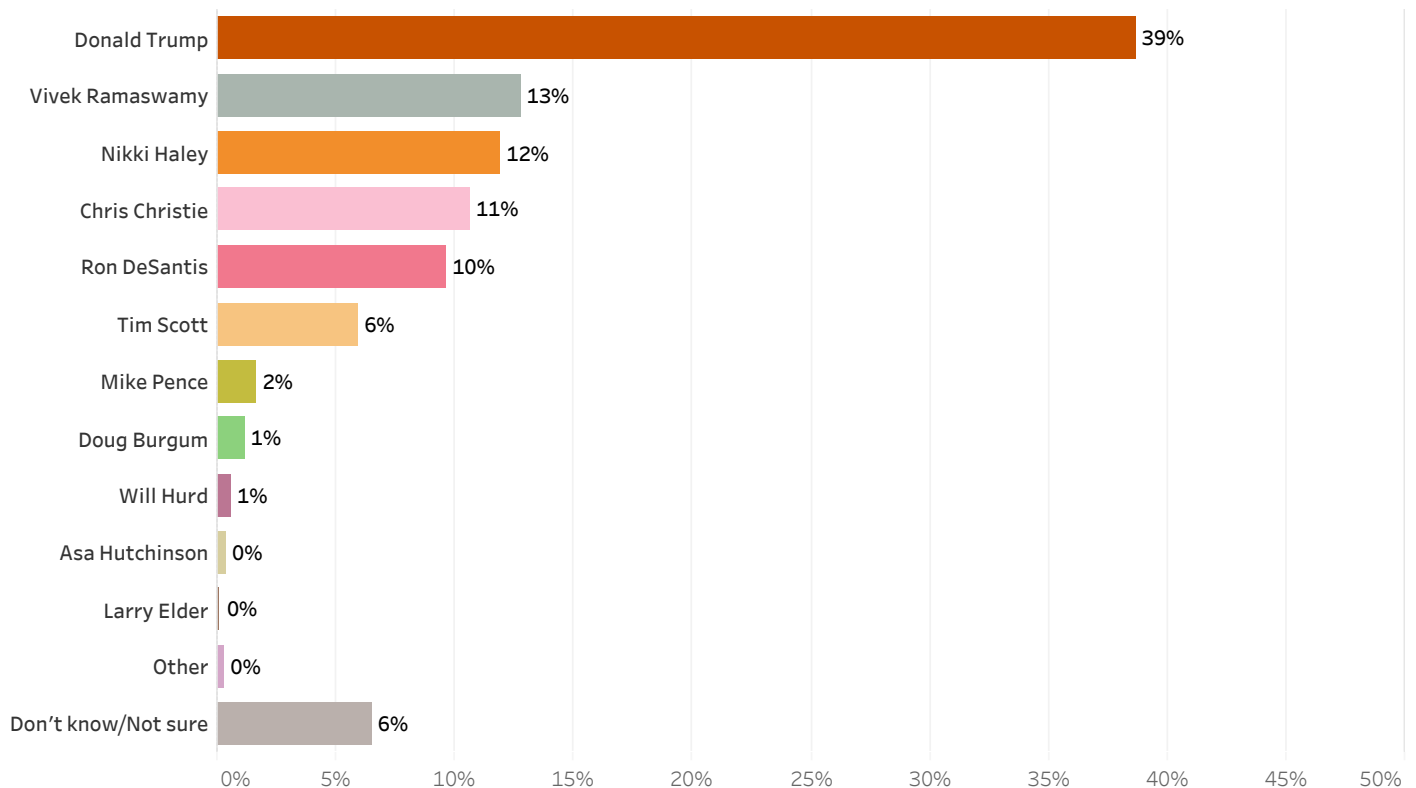
DURHAM, NH - Former President Donald Trump continues to lead among likely 2024 Republican primary voters in New Hampshire, followed by entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy, former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley, former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie, and Florida Governor Ron DeSantis. Support for DeSantis has declined considerably since January while support for Ramaswamy, Haley, and Christie has increased.

### 2024 Republican Presidential Primary

Four months before the New Hampshire Primary, former President Donald Trump continues to lead among likely Republican primary voters. Thirty-nine percent of likely primary voters support Trump, followed by entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy (13%), former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley (12%), former New Jersey Governor Chris Christie (11%), and Florida Governor Ron DeSantis (10%). Six percent support South Carolina Senator Tim Scott, 2% support former Vice President Mike Pence, and 1% or less support North Dakota Governor Doug Burgum (1%), former Texas Congressman Will Hurd (1%), former Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson (<1%), or talk show host Larry Elder (<1%). Less than 1% support another candidate while 6% are unsure whom they would support. Businessman Perry Johnson is not supported by any likely Republican primary voters.

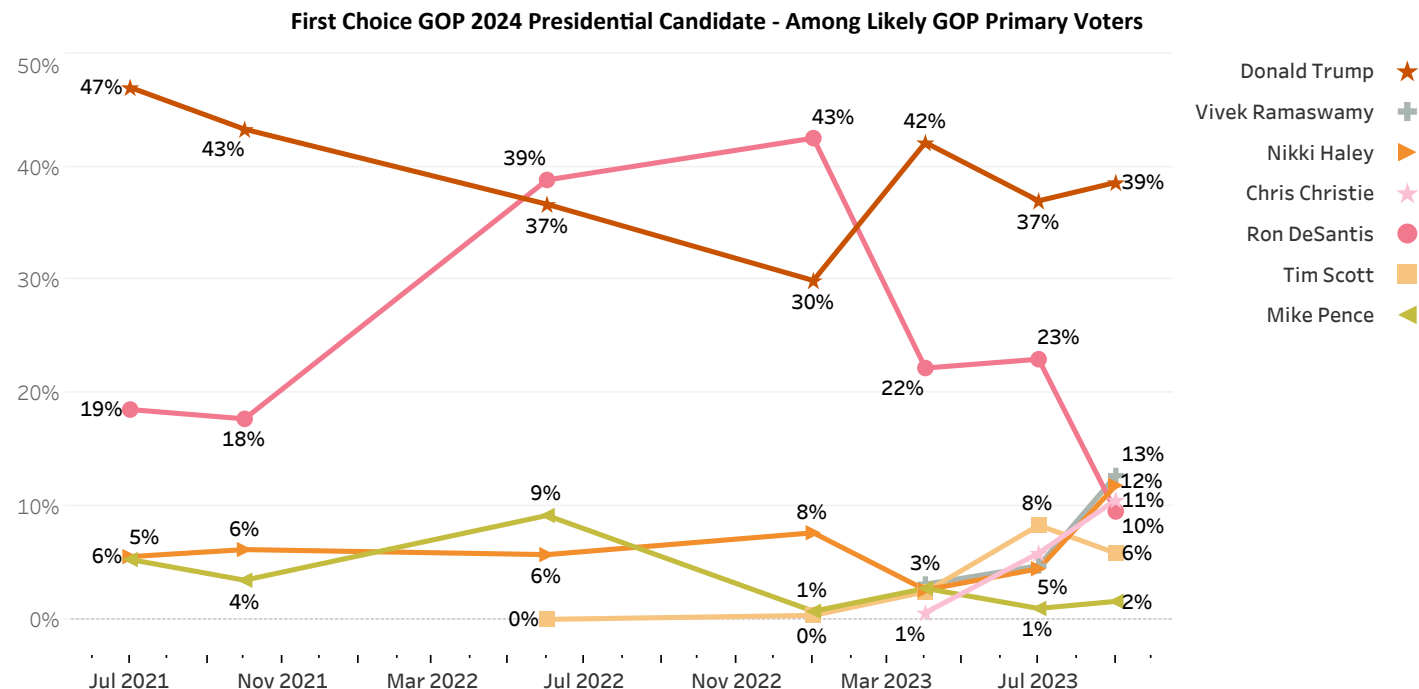
A majority of self-described conservatives (57%) support Trump, while most libertarians support Trump (37%) or Ramaswamy (32%) and nearly half of moderates support Haley (24%) or Christie (22%).

**First Choice GOP 2024 Presidential Candidate - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - September 2023**



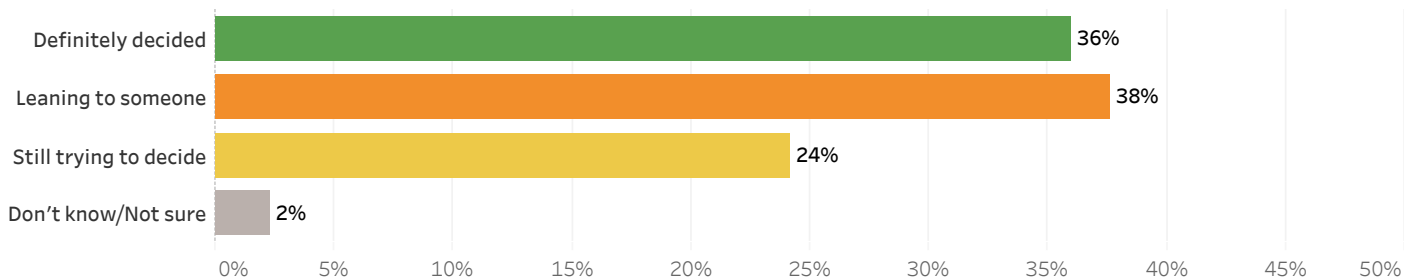

Support for Trump is largely unchanged since July. Support for Ramaswamy (+8 percentage points), Haley (+7), and Christie (+5) have increased since July while support for DeSantis (-13) has fallen by more than half.



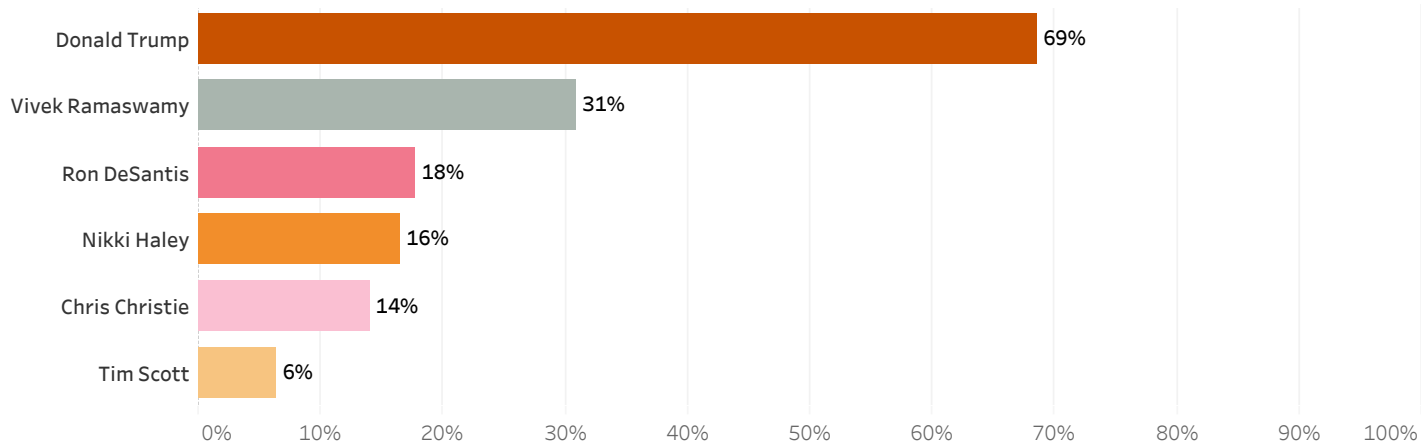
Despite Trump's lead, only 36% of likely 2024 Republican primary voters say that they have definitely decided who they will vote for, 38% say they are leaning toward someone, and 24% are still trying to decide. Respondents are slightly more likely to say they are still trying to decide (24%) than in July (17%).

However, seven in ten (69%) Trump supporters say they have definitely decided, while 31% of Ramaswamy supporters have definitely decided and less than one-fifth of DeSantis (18%), Haley (16%), Christie (14%), and Scott (6%) supporters say they have definitely decided.

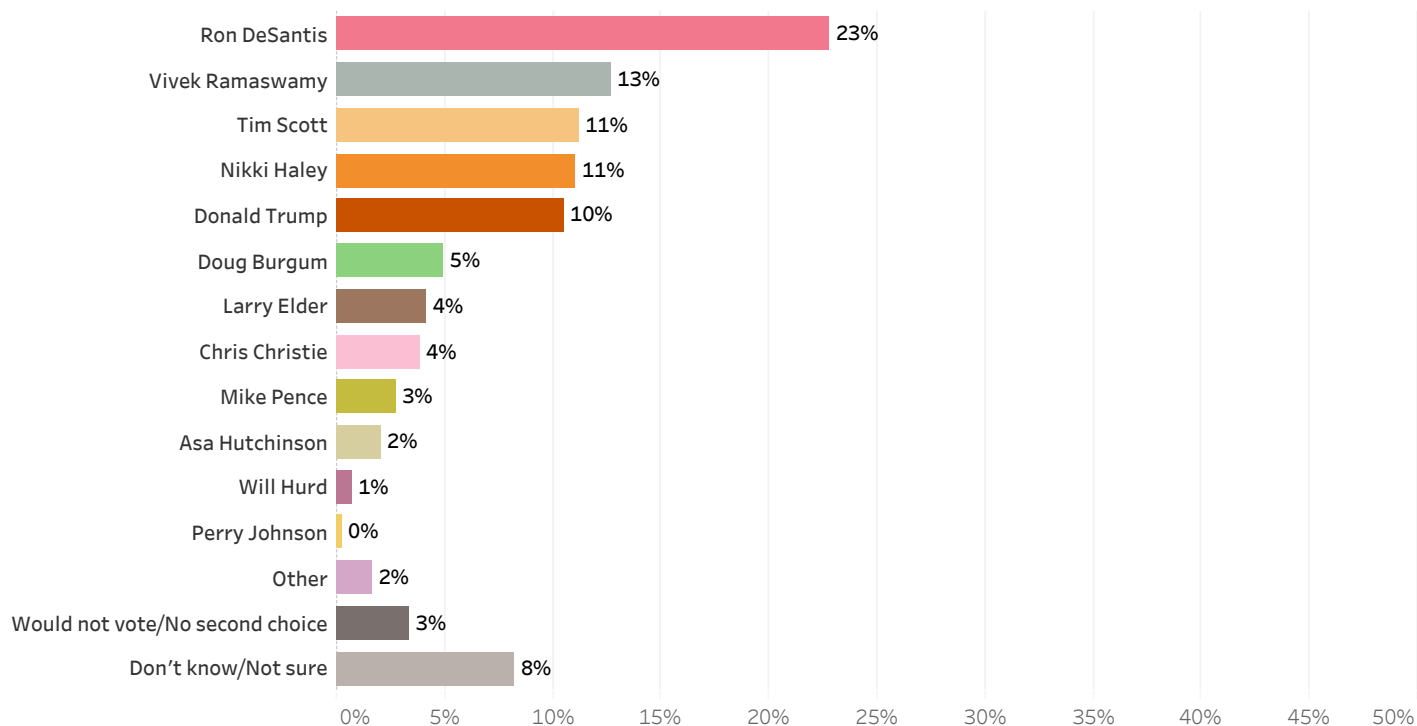

When asked which candidate is their second choice, 23% of likely New Hampshire Republican primary voters choose DeSantis, followed by Ramaswamy (13%), Scott (11%), Haley (11%), and Trump (10%).

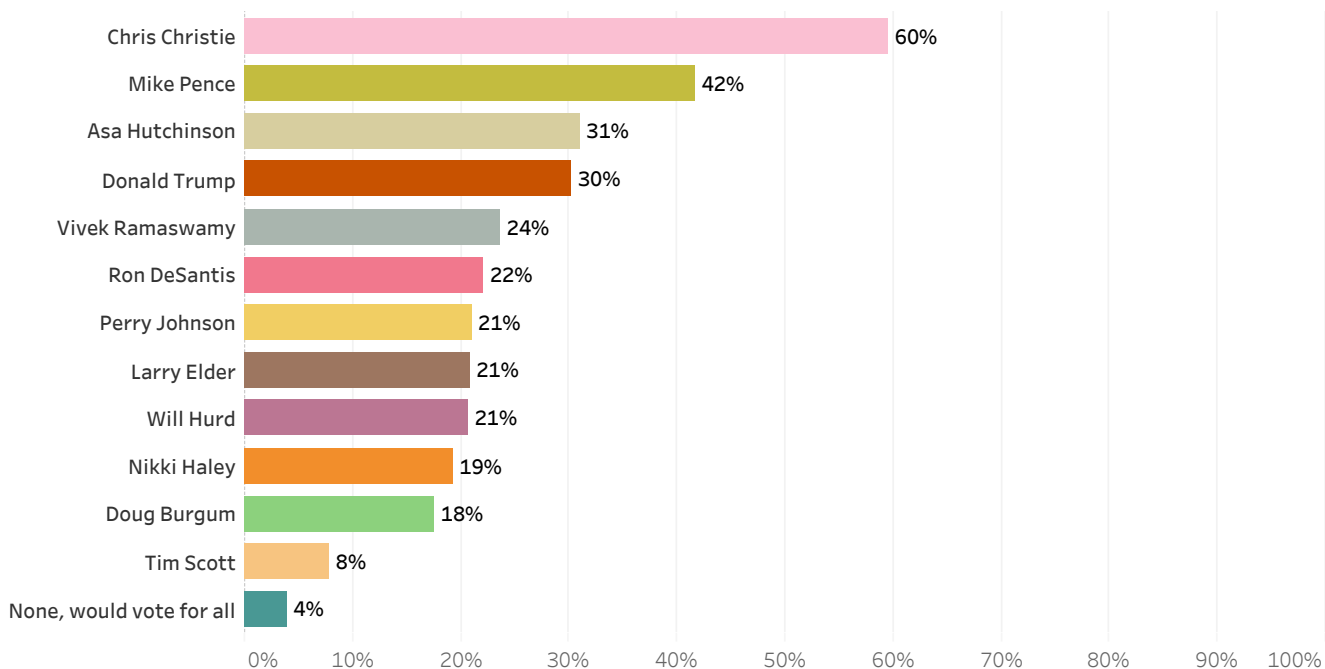
Trump supporters most often select DeSantis and Ramaswamy as their second choice, Ramaswamy voters most often choose DeSantis and Trump, Haley voters most often choose DeSantis, Christie, and Scott, Christie voters most often choose Haley, and DeSantis voters most often choose Trump or Haley as their second choice.

Six in ten (60%) likely Republican primary voters say they would not vote for Christie under any circumstances, 42% would not vote for Pence, 31% would not vote for Hutchinson, and 30% would not vote for Trump under any circumstances while only 4% say that they would vote for all of the below Republican candidates.

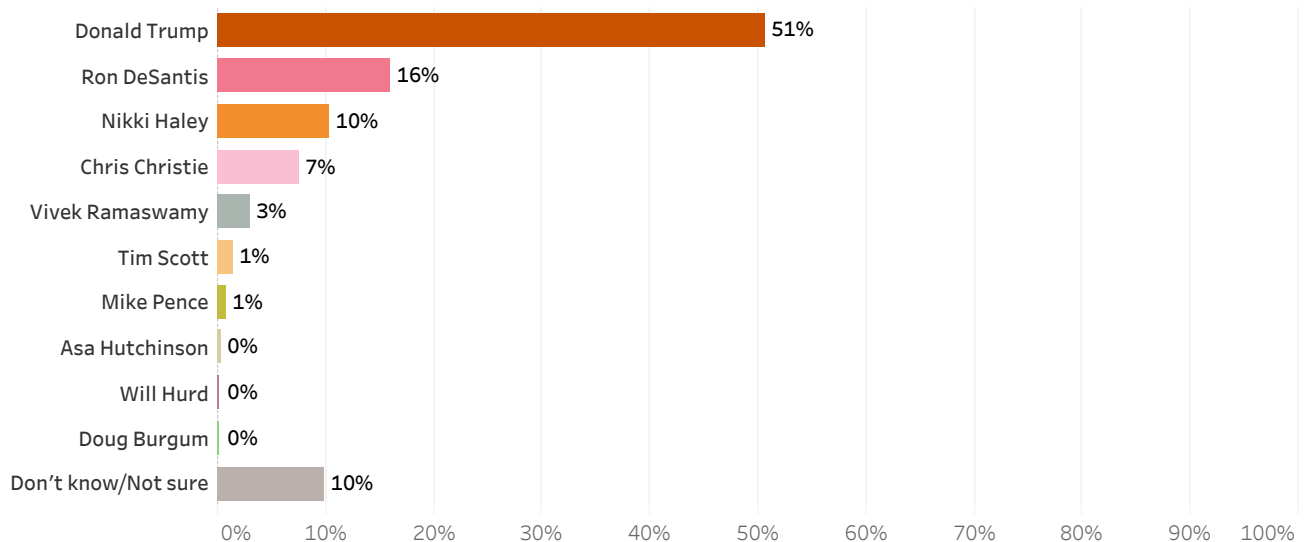

Half (51%) of likely 2024 New Hampshire Republican primary voters think that Trump has the best chance to win the 2024 presidential general election followed by DeSantis (16%), Haley (10%), and Christie (7%).

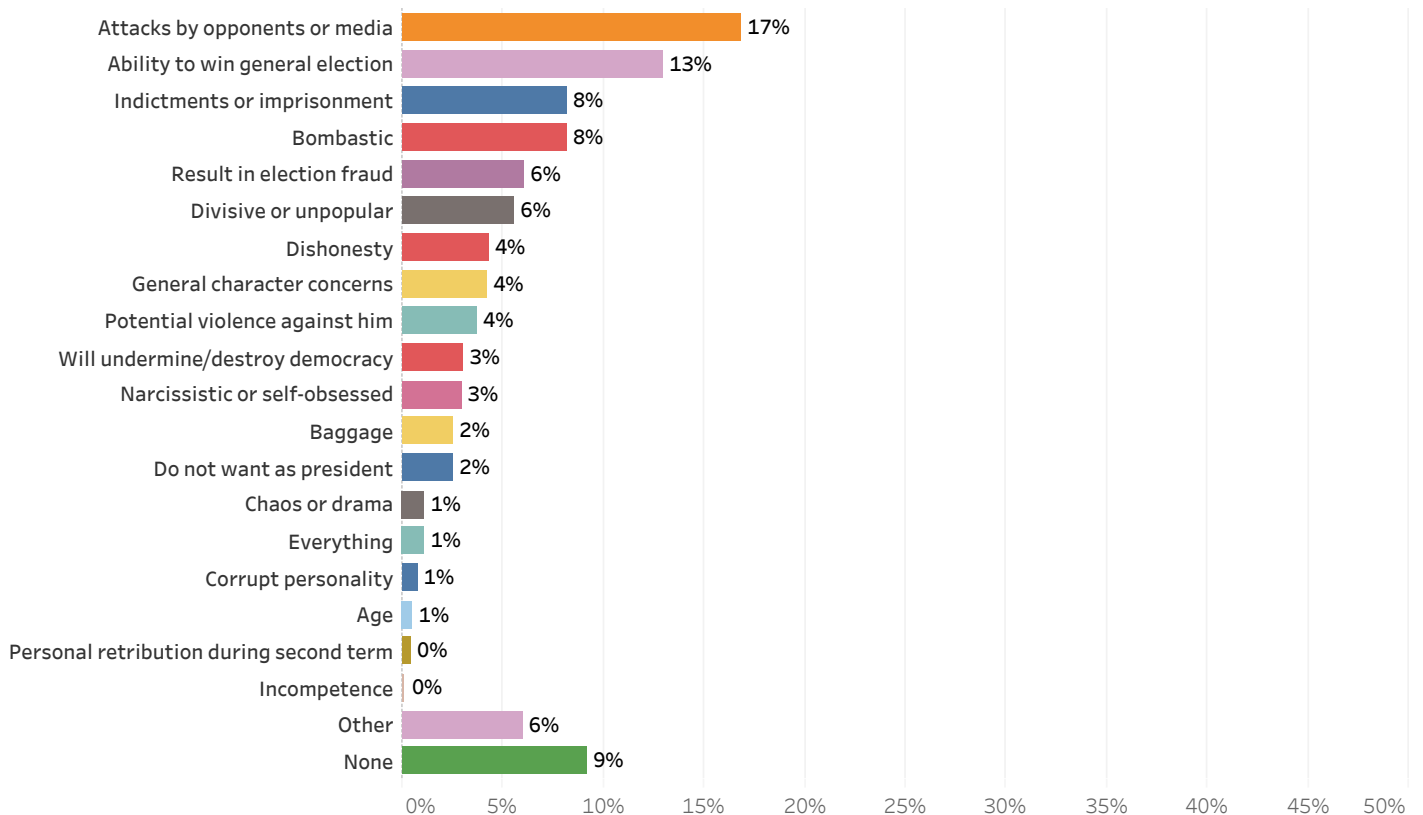
Nearly all (98%) Trump supporters think he has the best chance of winning the general election. By comparison, only 66% of Christie supporters, 63% of Haley supporters, 59% of DeSantis supporters, and 21% of Ramaswamy supporters think their preferred candidate has the best chance of winning the general election.

When asked what, if anything, is their biggest concern about Trump as the 2024 Republican nominee, 17% of likely Republican primary voters mention attacks by opponents or the media, while slightly fewer mention Trump's ability to win a general election (13%), his indictments or possible imprisonment (8%), him being bombastic (8%), his nomination resulting in election fraud (6%), or him being divisive or unpopular (6%), while 9% say they have no concerns. Trump supporters are more likely than others to say they are concerned about potential violence against Trump and potential voter fraud by Trump's opponents.

### Biggest Concern if Trump is 2024 GOP Nominee (coded) - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - September 2023

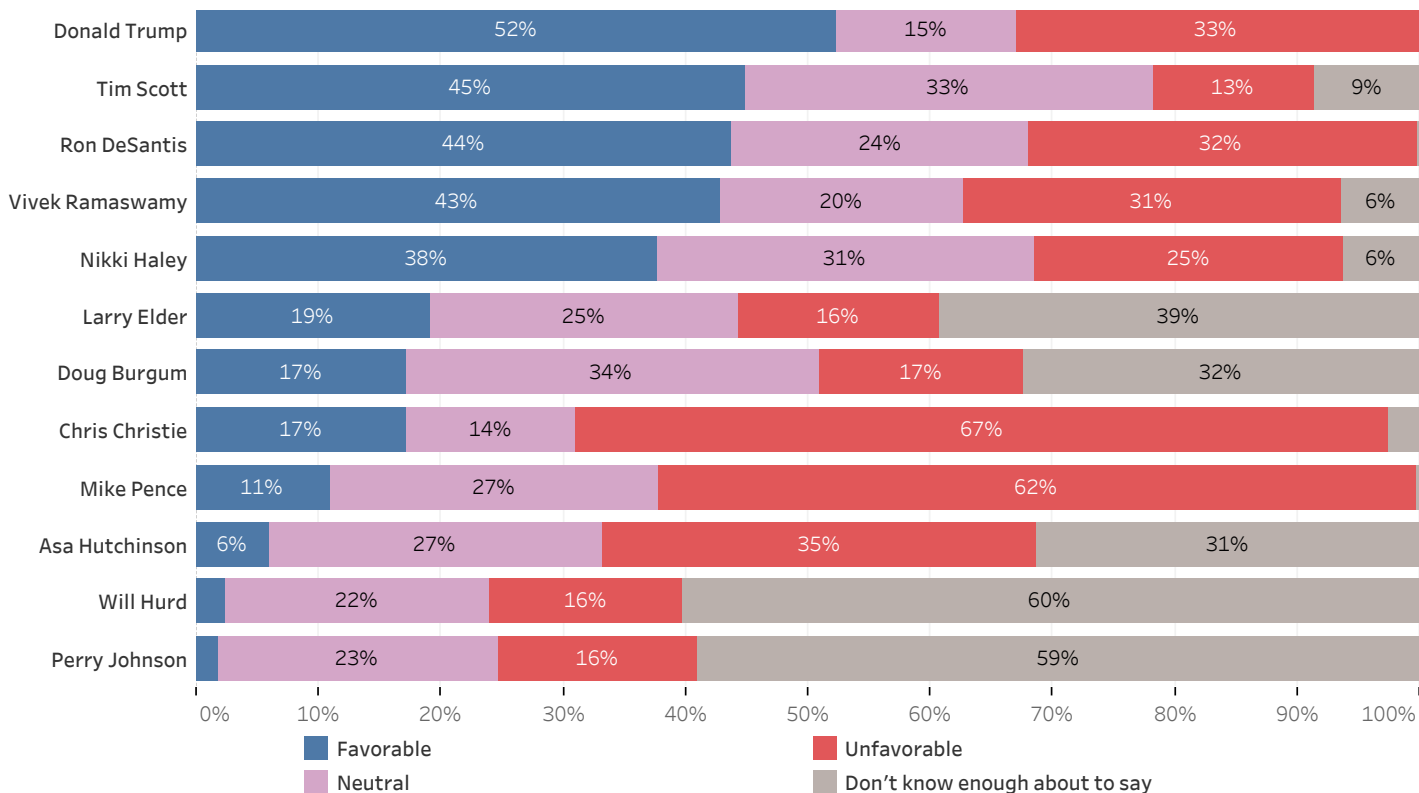


### Awareness of GOP Candidates

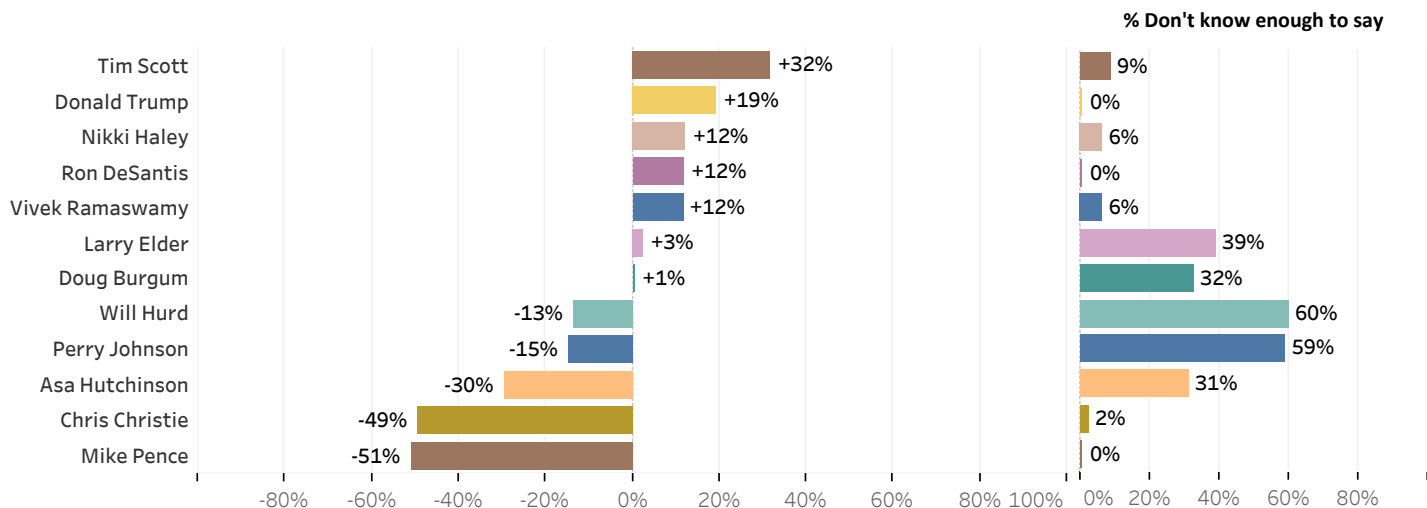
Among likely 2024 Republican New Hampshire presidential primary voters, Scott is the most popular candidate: 45% of likely Republican primary voters have a favorable opinion of Scott, only 13% have an unfavorable opinion of him, 33% are neutral, and 9% don't know enough about him to say. Scott's net favorability rating (the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus the percentage with an unfavorable opinion) is +32. Trump (+19) has the next highest net favorability rating, followed by Haley (+12), DeSantis (+12), and Ramaswamy (+12). Likely Republican primary voters are largely neutral on Elder (+3) and Burgum (+1), while likely GOP primary voters are slightly negative in their feelings towards Hurd (-13) and Johnson (-15) while Hutchinson (-30), Christie (-49), and Pence (-51) are generally unpopular among likely GOP primary voters. Many likely GOP primary voters don't know enough to have an opinion about Hurd (60%), Johnson (59%), Elder (39%), Burgum (32%), and Hutchinson (31%).

Haley (+16 percentage points) and Hurd (+10) are more popular than in July among likely Republican primary voters while Ramaswamy (-28), DeSantis (-20), Pence (-18), Scott (-14), and Hutchinson (-13) have seen their personal popularity decline.

**Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - September 2023**



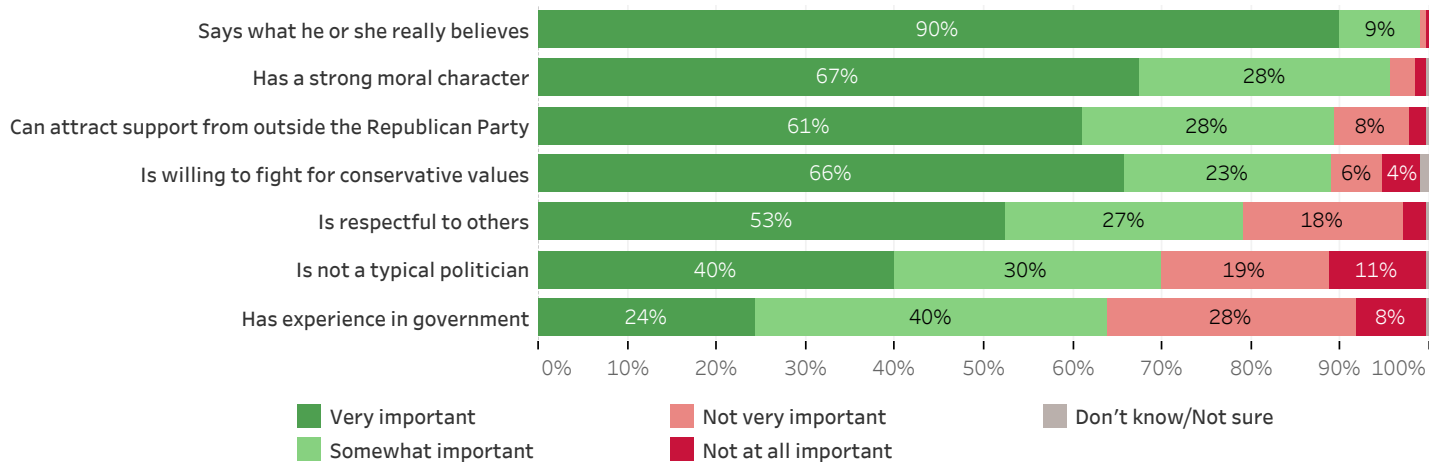
**Net Favorability - Potential 2024 Republican Candidates - Among Likely GOP Primary Voters - September 2023**



### Qualities of Nominee & Issues in GOP Primary

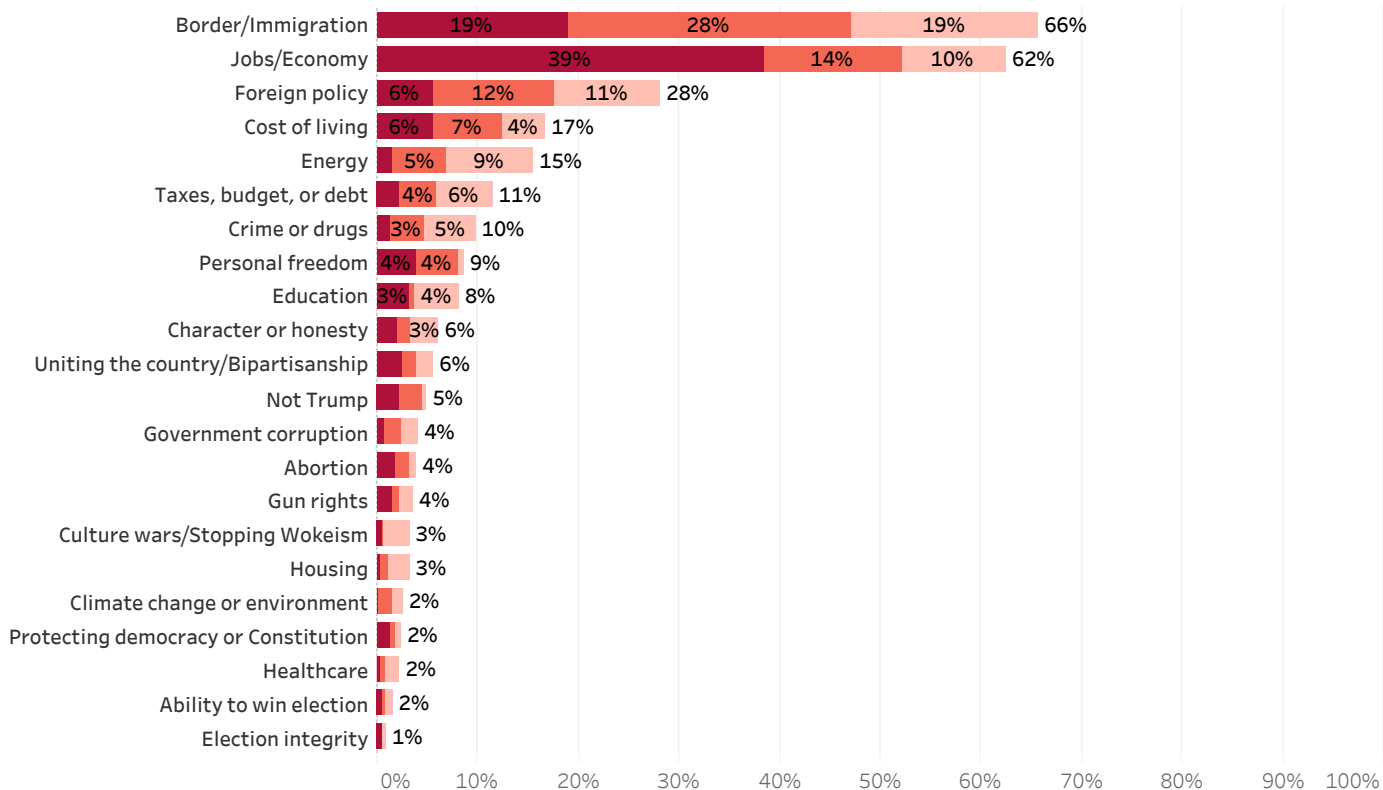
Nearly all (99%) likely Republican primary voters say it is very (90%) or somewhat (9%) important that the Republican nominee for president says what he or she really believes, while 96% believe it is important that they have a strong moral character. Clear majorities think it is important that the Republican candidate can attract support from outside the Republican Party (89%), is willing to fight for conservative values (89%), and is respectful of others (79%), while smaller majorities think it is important that the Republican candidate is not a typical politician (70%) or has experience in government (64%). Trump supporters are more likely than others to say it is important the Republican candidate is willing to fight for conservative values (>99%) and is not a typical politician (90%) while they are less likely to say it is important that the candidate be respectful to others (61%).

Majorities of likely Republican primary voters mention the border or immigration (66%) and jobs or the economy (62%) as among their top three most important issues when deciding on a candidate. Smaller numbers mention foreign policy (28%), the cost of living (17%), energy (15%), taxes, the budget, or the debt (11%), or crime or drugs (10%) as among their top three issues. Trump supporters are more likely than others to mention the border or immigration, the cost of living, and personal freedom, while non-Trump supporters are more likely to mention jobs or the economy, foreign policy, taxes, the budget, or the debt, or the candidate's character or honesty.

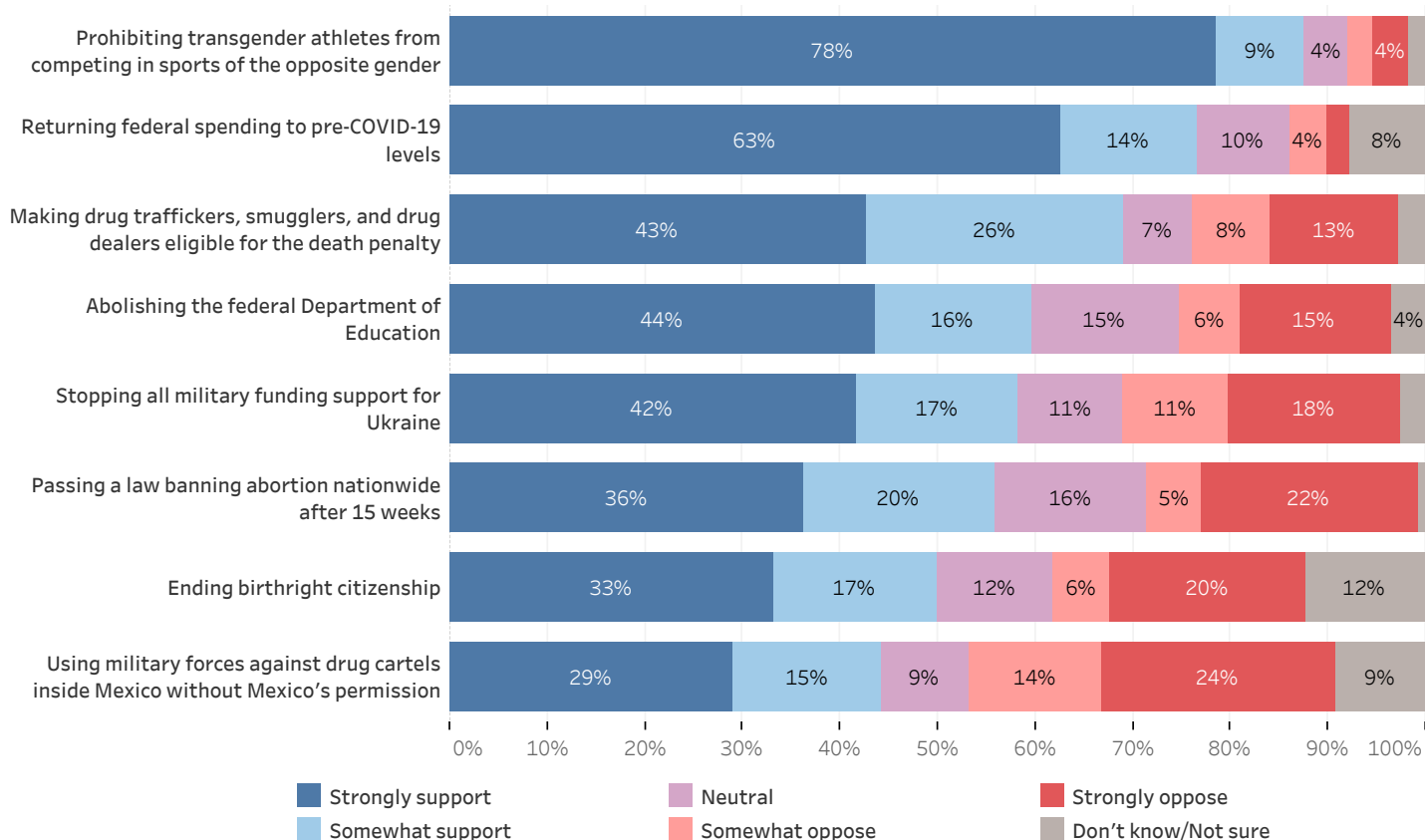
#### Three Most Important Issues in Deciding Candidate to Support - September 2023



Likely 2024 Republican primary voters were asked whether they support or oppose several policies which have been proposed by one or more Republican presidential candidates. Most likely Republican primary voters (88%) strongly (78%) or somewhat (9%) support requiring that transgender athletes compete on teams that match the sex they were assigned at birth, returning federal spending to pre-COVID-19 levels (77%), and making drug traffickers, smugglers, and drug dealers eligible for the death penalty (69%). Smaller majorities are in favor of abolishing the federal Department of Education (60%), stopping all military funding support for Ukraine (58%), and banning abortion nationwide after 15 weeks (56%). Half (50%) support ending birthright citizenship while only 44% support using military forces against drug cartels inside Mexico without Mexico's permission.

Majorities of Trump voters support all of these policies, while half of Christie voters or less support each policy. Ramaswamy voters are particularly likely to support ending birthright citizenship while Haley voters are particularly unlikely to support this. DeSantis voters are particularly likely to support making drug distributors eligible for the death penalty, stopping all military aid to Ukraine, and using military force inside Mexico without their permission.

## CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Two thousand, one hundred and seven (2,107) Granite State Panel members completed the survey online between September 14 and September 18, 2023. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 2.1 percent. Included in the sample were 1,006 likely 2024 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 3.4 percent). There were 845 unweighted likely Republican Primary voters. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response. These MSE's have not been adjusted for design effect. The response rate for this CNN New Hampshire Primary Poll is 34%. The design effect for the survey is 2.6%.

The Granite State Panel is a probability-based web panel of New Hampshire residents. Approximately 6,500 New Hampshire adults have been recruited from phone, text-to-web, or mail-to-web surveys sent to randomly-selected phone numbers or addresses. Panelists are then asked to participate in online surveys sponsored by the UNH Survey Center.

Data were weighted by respondent sex, age, education, and region of the state to targets from the most recent American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, as well as party registration levels provided by the NH Secretary of State and to 2020 election results in New Hampshire. Surveys were taken in English, all respondent data included passes Qualtrics data quality checks, and single-use survey links were used to prevent multiple submissions by respondents.

The number of respondents in each demographic below may not equal the number reported in cross-tabulation tables as some respondents choose not to answer some questions. Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%. All coding of open-ended responses is conducted by human coders.
