CONCORD —Jon Morgan (35), of Brentwood, officially filed his candidacy for New Hampshire’s 23rd state Senate district today at the State House in Concord. Morgan was raised in New Hampshire and is a cybersecurity professional with a background in international business development. He currently serves as a member of the Planning Board in Brentwood, where he lives with his wife of eight years, Katie, and their three young sons.

He gave the following statement: “I’m proud to be raising my three boys with the same Granite State values of hard work, integrity, and service that my parents instilled in me while I was growing up in Manchester. After many conversations around our kitchen table, Katie and I decided that this run for state Senate was how we were going to leave the woodpile a little higher than we found it. Our economy here in New Hampshire is grounded in innovation and small business. Politicians in Concord aren’t doing a good enough job of recognizing and acting on this reality. In November, we must elect more candidates with the experience and foresight to make strategic decisions about how to best grow our economy.
